Andre Malraux Zebra Crossing

Proposal for transport and highways improvements

Background

Andre Malraux School (an independent primary school) in Hanwell are concerned about the safety of their school children outside the school because they feel the road is used as a cut through from Greenford Avenue that increases the volume of traffic passing the school at the start and end of the school day. The school has therefore requested to upgrade the existing raised crossing point on Bordars Road to a raised zebra crossing.

Introducing a raised zebra crossing would significantly improve safety by providing a clearly designated pedestrian priority crossing that is understood by drivers.

The council has developed proposals to upgrade the existing crossing point to a raised zebra crossing to improve road safety as shown on the attached plan.

Proposals

- Upgrading a raised crossing point to a raised zebra crossing to improve safety for pedestrians and reduce vehicular speed.
- Remove existing school keep clear markings that only operates during school drop off and pick up times
- Relocate existing disabled bay to improve sight lines
- Provide 2 cycle stands

What impact will the proposals have?

There will be a loss of approximately 5 uncontrolled parking spaces in correspondence of the proposed zig-zag road markings.

What are the benefits of the proposals?

- Providing zebra crossing provides better customer information and provides a certain location for pedestrian, which in particular benefits mobility, cognitive and visually impaired passengers.
- The addition of zig-zag markings would enhance safety by preventing parking and stopping near the crossing at all times thereby ensuring clear sight lines for both drivers and pedestrians
- Reduce vehicle speeds at a critical crossing point
- Improved pedestrian safety for primary school children and accompanying adults

What happens next?

The responses to this consultation will be analysed and reported to your ward councillors and the Cabinet Member for Climate Action. A decision will then be taken regarding implementation of the scheme. If the scheme is approved, the design may be amended based on the feedback received during this consultation.

Before implementation, the Council is required to carry out a 21 day statutory consultation. This involves notices being placed on posts and lamp columns in the proposed area and the publication of the notice within the Ealing Gazette. This process provides the public with a further opportunity to comment on the proposals.
